

Club, Beach, & Dock Rules

These apply throughout the calendar year

Club Rules:

1. Safety rules must be followed by all members and guests on Club premises and at Club events.
2. Only members in good standing are allowed to participate in Club events.
3. Profane and abusive language or disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. The Club's General Manager or the ranking Club Officer present has the authority to summarily evict any person violating this rule from the Club premises and will report such conduct to the Board of Directors for further disciplinary action.
4. No smoking, including E-cigarettes (vaping), anywhere on Club premises except in the designated parking lot area.
5. No personal alcohol on Club premises while the Club is open for business.
6. No overnight parking, sleeping or camping on Club premises without prior approval of the Board of Directors.
7. Members and guests are not permitted in Club galley or snack bar at any time unless approved by the House Committee and may not use the items stored therein without permission of the General Manager.
8. Animals, including service animals or service animals "in training," are not permitted on Club premises (Clubhouse, parking lot, beach, docks, deck and patio), with the exception of licensed guide dogs for the blind, which are in service of a blind person at the Club.
9. Young children must be supervised at all times. There shall be no running or rough housing at any time.
10. Water balloons are not allowed at LAYC.

Beach Rules:

1. No fishing from the beach.
2. Children must be supervised at all times
3. Children must be capable of swimming to safety or wear a Coast Guard approved flotation device (PFD)
4. No swimming under docks or around sailboat lifts
5. No fishing off the dock or beach
6. No waterskiing from or to dock
7. No powerboats allowed to launch from the Club ramp
8. No animals are allowed on dock, beach or in Clubhouse
9. No smoking or vaping.

Dock Rules:

1. No fishing from the dock.
2. No water skiing from the dock or landing skiers on the dock.
3. No overnight parking in slips.

4. If a member rents their house or boat, no boat docking privileges, or other privileges will be allowed their renter.
5. No powerboat of any type may be launched at the Club.
6. Only a member's sailboats with current registration and ALA sticker (except guest sailboats at Club sponsored regattas) may be launched or used at the Club
7. Boats fifteen (15) feet and under are not allowed in slips but may be side-tied in designated areas on the docks.
8. Swimming from the dock is limited to the area by the slide and areas where powerboats do not generally dock except during authorized swimming classes or events.
9. Children on the dock must be capable of swimming to safety or must wear a Coast Guard approved life jacket (PFD).
10. Only one person at a time may be on the water slide and its steps. There shall be no jumping from the slide.
